Testimonial for FunctionEight

We were asked to project-manage an online website implementation for TWA The Waitakere Agency (TWA is an Auckland-based Talent Agency) late last year. TWA needed to implement a secure online casting website at relatively short notice.

We first discussed plans with FunctionEight to build a website for TWA in late August of 2010. Because the business of TWA is quite unique, we did expect the work to take significantly longer to complete.

We commissioned FunctionEight to start development work on the site in mid-October, with a projected completion date of December 2010. The site was completed within the quoted budget and went "live" as planned, the week before Xmas 2010.

We found that one of the advantages of having a website developed and maintained in Hong Kong, is the time-zone difference. During the development phase we would work out what the next steps should be during the day; instruct FunctionEight staff; they would implement the changes early that evening; and quite often we could then communicate any refinements later in the evening and then get them fully tested and implemented before the next working day.

During the development phase we found the staff at FunctionEight a real pleasure to work with. They are extremely helpful people, pro-active and true professionals with a "can-do" attitude. Their standard of work is very high. Every change-request was addressed promptly and efficiently.

As always, there were a few small changes post-implementation, which were also dealt with swiftly and professionally.

In summary, this has been one of the most successful website development implementations that I have worked on to date.

I would recommend FunctionEight to anyone who wants a professional website developed on time and within the quoted budget.
